We need both pages so we will have your information for the 2007 Handbook/ Directory AND for us to know if you want to order a copy of the Directory and DVD of the events.

## Questions and Answers

Q -- When and how do I register?

A -- Do it right now! Complete the registration form and data sheets as soon as possible because we need to have attendance estimates and information about you and your activities with plenty of lead time to enable us to complete the Handbook and Class Directory. If you aren't absolutely sure about your plans, please register anyway. We guarantee a full refund up until September 7, 2007.

Q -- What is the cost?

A -- \$107 per person. This covers three big days of fun and reunion events for each person attending. Should you wish to bring additional guests or family members to the Sunday afternoon picnic, the cost will be \$15 for each guest attending the picnic only.

Q -- What does the registration fee include?

A -- For starters, it covers 1) our use of the Marriott Hospitality Suite for the Friday night get-together, including light refreshments and soft drinks, wine, and beer; 2) the Marriott Ballroom for the Saturday night buffet dinner and dance, featuring a DJ with (what else!) hit tunes from the 'Fifties; and 3) all the great food you can eat and a selection of beverages at the catered Sunday picnic in the mountains. Each classmate will also get the new Class of '57 Handbook/ Directory with updated addresses and personal profiles for everyone we are able to reach, *plus* a DVD of the 2007 reunion events.

Q -- I'm coming from out of town. Is there a special deal I can make on hotel reservations?

A -- Definitely. Or, even if you are not coming from out of town, make it a weekend get-away! Call Marriott Reservations at 1-800-334-2086 and ask for **Highland High School Class of '57 Group Rates at the Albuquerque Marriott**. Our Group Code is **HIGHIGA**. There are a limited number of rooms blocked for our event, so early booking is advised. If you decide to come a few days early or stay a few days longer, the Marriott will extend the special rate provided you book by September 7.
